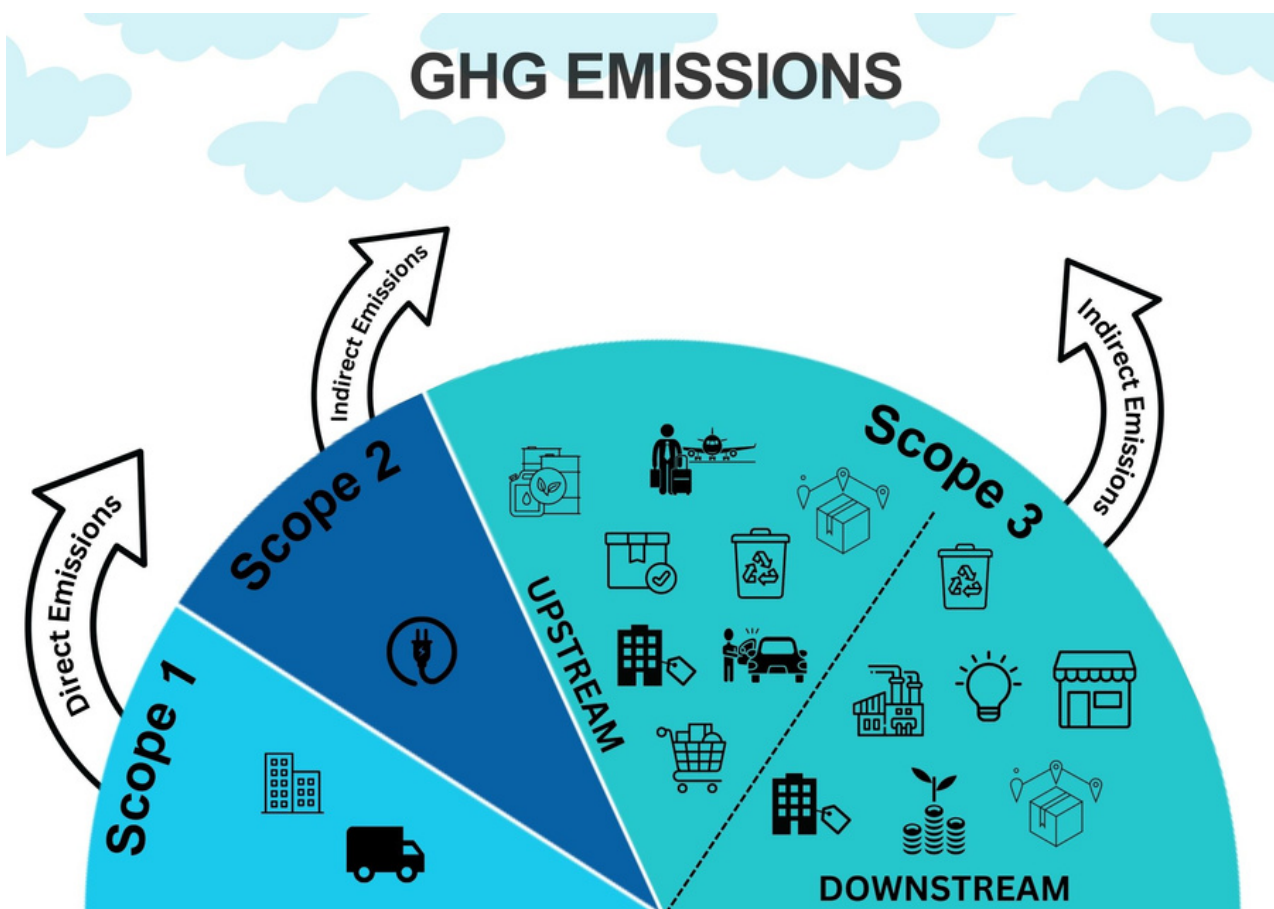

More on Scope 3 emissions

Managing Scope 3 emissions is essential for organizations committed to sustainability, as it involves collaborating with suppliers, partners, and stakeholders to drive emission reductions throughout the entire lifecycle of products and services.

Scope 3 emissions enables organizations to take responsibility for the GHG impact associated with their value chain and promote sustainability practices across a wider spectrum of activities.

Scope 3 emissions are indirect greenhouse gas emissions that result from an organization's value chain activities.

They encompass a broad range of sources, including purchased goods and services, business travel, employee commuting, waste generation, and product transportation.

Scope 3 emissions occur outside of the organization's direct control but contribute significantly to its overall carbon footprint.

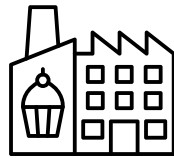

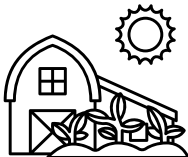
